The **mixed building waste container** is not only for mineral waste such as concrete, tiles, bricks and ceramics, but also for waste made from wood, glass, metal, cardboard or plastic.



- Crushed concrete
- Gypsum
- Glass remnants
- Wood remnants
- Tiles
- Ceramic (without plastic parts)
- Plastic, foil and cardboard remnants
- Masonry
- Mortar and plaster remnants
- Sand
- Stones
- Leftover wallpaper
- Bricks



- Pressure vessels such as gas cylinders, fire extinguishers or spray cans (emptied of residues)
- Paints, varnishes and oils
- Furniture and bulky waste
- Polystyrene and insulation materials

Note: For the proper disposal of construction waste which may contain harmful substances, for instance roofing felt, broken chimney waste, mastic asphalt, crushed concrete with mineral oil or insulating paint, please contact our customer service.
